## SAFE HAVEN CHILD ACCESS TRANSFER CENTER



The Children's Rights Council is a not for profit organization that helps to establish these centers to assist the children of separated, divorced, and never married couples during the stresses of family breakup. The Central Maryland Safe Haven Child Access Transfer Center provides a safe and monitored environment where children can be exchanged for weekend visitation. Monitors are present to assist in the exchange of the child(ren) and parents do not have to see each other at the Center. Referrals can be made by the Courts, attorneys, counselors, mediators and social workers. Self-referrals are also possible.
